

English - Fantasy Story, Letters, Descriptive writing, Play Script, Non-chronological Reports.

- To start the term, children will recap prior learning such as modal verbs, similes and metaphors and explore how to convey atmosphere in their first independent write of the year - a fantasy story.
- Inspired by The Adventures of Odysseus by Daniel Morden, owls will write letters in the 1st person in character as an ancient greek, demonstrating their ability to remain consistent in their use of tense, use passive verbs to build tension, figurative language to engage the reader and demonstrate their understanding of the key features of a letter.
- In anticipation of our trip to Warner Bros Studio Tours, Owls will explore the intricacies of progressing a narrative through dialogue in our Harry Potter inspired Play Script unit.
- Year 6 will research, write and publish a Non-chronological Report linked to our Geography topic. Owls will be expected to showcase all the key features of this genre.
- Towards the end of the term, the Owls will also write a detective story, inspired by our investigations in Science in which they will showcase the skills they have developed in prior units.
